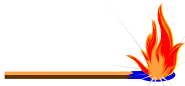

EAST METRO PARK CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

The following construction items are substantially completed under phase one: (expected open date is June 2006)

1. Primary and secondary electrical systems
2. Potable water system
3. Irrigation main water system (connected to potable water system)
4. Soccer fields
5. Football fields
6. Basketball Court
7. Soccer field concession area and restroom
8. Baseball Concession area and restroom
9. Bullfrog restroom
10. All four playgrounds (soccer, baseball, bullfrog and pool)
11. All seven trash enclosures
12. Internal roadway and parking areas including lightings
13. Concrete hike and bike trail
14. Kiosk structure (except the sign)
15. Fishing pier
16. All 3 irrigation pump systems
17. All drainage systems
18. All septic systems
19. about 150 trees
20. Baseball fields excluding grass
21. Pool area and its infrastructures

To visit East Metro Park:

Going East on US 290 from I-35 take the FM 973 exit proceeding through Manor. After crossing the railroad tracks turn left on to Blake-Manor Road. Stay on Blake-Manor Road and the Park Entrance will be located on the right. The park entrance is about 3.5 miles on the right.

YMCA will open the pool the Saturday before Memorial Day and stay open thru Labor Day weekend

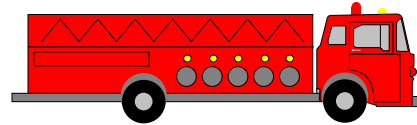

CREATION OF AN EMERGENCY SERVICE DISTRICT?



On February 21, 2006, Travis County Commissioners Court set a public hearing for an election to be held to determine whether or not the proposed emergency service district shall be created.

On February 28, 2006, Travis County Commissioners Court voted on accepting the petition for the creation of an Emergency Services District #13 in the part of Northeast Travis County that is not currently served by another district.

The Travis County Commissioner's Court voted to hold an election to create an Emergency Service District on May 13, 2006
